

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Can you build the three houses for the three pigs using construction materials? Can you use three different resources that you can find either inside or outside. Using a hairdryer or blowing with a big huff and a puff, can you blow your houses down?

- Draw the 3 little pigs with heads that are different shapes. You could make a square little pig, a rectangle little pig, a heart little pig. What other shapes can you draw?



- Using your set of number cards from last week 0 - 10. Mix them up and then pick up two. Can you make a subtraction number sentence using these 2 numbers? Remember the biggest number needs to go first. E.g. $10 - 4 =$

Can you use a number line to work out the answers? If you want a challenge, try with numbers up to 20.

- Practice your doubles with numbers up to 10. Using paper, splodge some dots onto one side of the paper, fold it in half and you'll double the number of dots. Can you write the double number sentences?

- Play number bingo with numbers to 20 with people in your family. Choose 6 numbers 1 - 20 and then have someone call out a number or using your number cards, pick 1 at a time. Why not complete with a family member?



Weekly Phonics/Spelling Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Join in with the online daily phonics lessons. Your teacher will let you know which group to join in with and what time these videos are on.

- Carry on reading a variety of books at home. Can you spot the sounds and tricky words you have learnt? Follow this link to read e-books on the Oxford Owl website:

- Make yourself 'yes' and 'no' cards. Read these questions and use your yes/no cards to show the answers to an adult once you've read them.

Can a sun get wet?

Can a boat sail?

Can dogs swim?

Has a fox got six legs?

Is the moon far off?

Is all hair long?

Do you have a pair of socks?

- After making your pig's mask, can you sit and read the story of the week in a den?

- Can you find as many words as you can to rhyme with these words from our story of the week?



Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Read the story 'The Three Little Pigs'

- Can you answer these questions? What did the pigs make their houses out of? How did they trick the wolf? What happened to the wolf in the end?
- Either on your own or with members of your family, can you retell the story of The Three Little Pigs? Don't forget the characters will have different voices.
- The three pigs tricked the wolf by letting him fall into the pot of hot water. Have a discussion as a family, if you were one of the pigs, how would you trick the wolf? Do you all have the same ideas or different ones?
- Read these sentences and draw picture to go with them.
I can hear an owl hoot at night.
Jim has seven silver coins.
The vet can help the dog.
The farmer gets up at six in the morning.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- After having a discussion with your family, write a sentence of how you would trick the wolf if you were one of the three little pigs.
- Have an adult dictate these sentences to you for you to write. Remember to sound out the words you need to write carefully. Remember no peeking!

I am in a rush to get to the shops.
She will fill a bucket at the well.
I can see a pair of boots on the mat.
Bow down to the king and queen.

- After making the three houses for the pigs, can you write about what you made the three houses out of and which one was the strongest? Don't forget to draw a lovely picture of your three houses.
- After your science experiment of blowing your objects off the table, label the items.
- If you were a pig, what would you build your house with? Draw a picture of your house and then write about what you would build your house with.

Other activities (to be completed through the week)

Create

Make a mask for one of the little pigs. You could cut out some card or use a paper plate to make your mask.

Make

Make puppets for each of the characters in our story for the week. You could use some of your sticks from last week to use or you could use lollypop sticks to make your puppets.

Craft

Blow painting. Using a straw and with some paint on a piece of paper, can you blow the paint around on the paper. Can you then make it into something?

Do

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) activity - Find things around the house that you can blow by huffing and puffing at it. Place the objects on to a table and then see if you can blow it off. Can you then sort it to show which items you could and couldn't blow off the table?

Be active

Listen, sing and clap along to the 'Three Little Pig' song.
