### Reading

Reading can help us learn and it can also transport us to other worlds! We encourage all children to develop a love of reading at Even Swindon, and support them in doing so through a rewards system.

- 200 reads: Cake with Mrs Lowe
- 250 reads: Reading pin badge to be worn with pride
- 300 reads: Book from Mrs Lowe
