North Pole– The geographical northern most point on the Earth

South Pole– The most Southern point on the Earth.

Equator- a line on earth equal distance from the north and south poles, dividing the earth into northern and southern hemispheres

Continents- any of the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica)

Oceans- a very large expanse of sea, in particular each of the main areas into which the sea is divided geographically

City — A city is the largest type of settlement, containing lots of buildings and people. They usually have hospitals, sports facilities, universities, shops, many houses and a cathedral.

Town—A **town** is usually smaller than a city, but larger than a village. A town has lots of houses, primary and secondary schools, as well as sometimes having a railway station and shopping centres.

Village— A village is small, but may have houses, a shop and a post office.
