Homework Policy Overview



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Homework

We hope that your child/ren have now settled into the new homework routine and we really appreciate all the positive comments and feedback we have had since September around the new English and Maths focus. In addition to these weekly tasks, we would also like to remind parents of the other aspects of our homework policy. The detailed version can be found on our website but here is a quick-glance overview for each year group:

Year Group	Timing	Homework tasks		
Nursery	Daily story time Enquiries throughout the year	Books should be shared on a daily basis – Nursery have a lending library available. Questions will be posed on their class Instagram for children to investigate. Parents should respond to these posts with comments or pictures.		
Reception	Daily phonics practice Daily reading From term 3, alternate English and Maths tasks	Phonic sound cards and grapheme tiles practiced as the children learn them. 1 phonically decodable book to be read by child, one story book to be shared with the child. From term 3, homework is to be completed either in the homework book or evidenced their class Instagram page.		
Years 1 & 2	Reading daily for 10 mins. Daily practice of spellings and times tables. Up to 15 minutes for completing homework tasks.	The English and maths homework will be set weekly and will be reviewing concepts alread learned in class. This is to ensure that the children develop automaticity in retrieving key skills.		
Years 3 & 4	Reading daily for 15 mins. Daily practice of spellings and times tables. Up to 20 minutes for completing homework tasks.			
Years 5 & 6	Reading daily for 20 mins. Daily practise of spellings and consolidation of times tables Up to 30 minutes for completing Homework tasks.


