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Attendance and late arrivals

DON'T LET YOUR CHILD MISS OUT!

It is important that children arrive to school on time. <u>If they arrive</u> <u>late</u> they have a bad start to the day.



If your child arrives late for class:

- They miss out on important learning, which could affect their achievement.
- They miss out on the social time to settle into class.
- It can be embarrassing for them.
- They may disrupt the learning of the rest of the class and this is not fair on the rest of the children.

LATENESS = LOST LEARNING	
Figures calculated over a school year.	
5 minutes late each day	3 days lost!
10 minutes late each day	6.5 days lost!
20 minutes late each day	13 days lost!
30 minutes late each day	19 days lost!

What you can do:

- Have a regular routine for the start of the day.
- Help your child get their clothes and equipment ready before they go to bed.
- Set a reasonable bed time to make sure they get enough sleep.
- Leave time to take account for traffic

Years 3,4,5 & 6 - doors open at 8.40am and the register is taken at 8.45am.

Awards from outside of school




